Technical and financial bids are invited from NABL accredited / EPA approved laboratories for carrying out ambient, stack and work zone monitoring, collection and analysis of fuel, clay etc. in 50 brick kilns in different parts of the country under CPCB Project "Revision of COINDS for Bricks Kilns" during the working season starting from November 2011 to August 2012. 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TENDER NOTICE

Environmental Monitoring of Brick Kilns

1. PSCST has been working with brick sector since 1997 and has evolved better designs of kilns, provided training to the workmen and entrepreneurs on better feeding, firing and operating practices.

The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has entrusted the project on “Revision of Comprehensive Industry Document for Brick Kilns” to study and assess all four types of pollution viz air, water, noise & soil including solid waste and identify appropriate technology to control pollution. The monitoring is aimed at ultimately to frame the standards in consonance with the optimal working of brick kilns and evolving standards which are techno-economically feasible.

2. It is proposed to monitor 50 brick kilns from five different zones of the country i.e. North Zone, East Zone, Central Zone, West Zone and South Zone, to account for emissions from different designs of brick kilns, variation in the work practices, type and quality of raw material and fuel presently prevalent in different parts of the country. The working season of brick kilns vary in different zones of the country and ranges between November 2011 to August 2012.
3. PSCST intends to engage NABL accredited/EPA approved laboratories in relevant area having infrastructure for carrying out ambient, stack and work zone monitoring, collection and analysis of fuel, clay etc. in different parts of the country, as per the criterion listed in the DNIT in a time bound manner.
4. Bidding documents may be purchased from the office of PSCST from 28.10.2011 to 16.11.2011 for a non-refundable fee Rs.1000/- as indicated in the form of cash or demand draft on any scheduled bank payable at Chandigarh in favour of “Punjab State Council for Science & Technology”. PSCST will not be held responsible for the postal delay, if any, in the delivery of the documents or non-receipt of the same.
5. The bid document can be sent through Email on specific request by paying requisite fee in favour of “Punjab State Council for Science & Technology” by NEFT into HDFC Bank, Sector 8C, Chandigarh, Account No. 01071000083075 and IFSC – HDFC0000107.
6. Bids must be accompanied by earnest money in the form of Demand Draft for Rs 25,000/- payable at Chandigarh and drawn in favour of “Punjab State Council for Science & Technology”.

7. Bids must be delivered in the office of PSCST on or before 1500 hours on 17.11.2011. The Technical Bid will be opened on the same day at 1530 hours in the presence of the bidders who may be present at the time. If the office happens to be closed on the date of the receipt of the bids as specified, the bids will be received and opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
8. The financial bid of only those bidders, whose technical bid is approved by the committee, would be opened in the presence of responsive bidder's representative who chose to attend at the time and date to be intimated later in the PSCST's office.
9. The bids can be submitted by the individual or a consortium of not more than two agencies. MoU/agreement of consortium in original shall be provided.
10. The PSCST reserves the right to verify information submitted by the bidder and can also call for any additional information in proof of statements made in the application.
11. The PSCST reserves the right to reject any or all applications without assigning any reason.
12. Any false information or offers received without earnest money would be out-rightly rejected.
